#### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

This act designates the bridges on state highway 60 crossing the Current River that are located within the city limits of Van Buren collectively as the "Sgt. Dewayne Graham Jr. MO Highway Patrol Memorial Bridges". Under the act, the department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such bridges, with the costs to be paid for by the Missouri State Troopers Association.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
