DESCRIPTION

Current law provides that in forcible entry and detainer actions, and actions involving rent and possession, applications for a trial de novo or appeal shall not stay execution for restitution unless the defendant gives a bond to secure the damages obtained in the judgment. The proposed legislation provides that the bond must be a cash bond, which may be remitted to the court in the form of cash, a money order, or certified check.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
