FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

Small business that sell only emergency vehicles could be positively impacted as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal exempts dealers who sell only emergency vehicles from maintaining a bona fide place of business (including the related law enforcement certification requirements) and from meeting the minimum yearly sales.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
