## FISCAL ANALYSIS

## **ASSUMPTION**

Officials of the **Office of State Court Administrator** assume there is no fiscal impact on the Courts.

Officials of the **Department of Natural Resources** assume no fiscal impact to the department.

Officials of the **St. Charles County- Public Water Supply District No. 2** assume this proposal would decrease the potential for the water district to expand its customer base, and would leave it with the same amount of debt.

Officials of the Callaway County- Public Water Supply District # 1 assume no fiscal impact.

Officials of the City of West Plains assume minimal fiscal impact.

**Oversight** assumes that existing law provides for detachment of property in water districts and this proposals clarifies existing law. Current law already provides for Court oversight of the detachment process. **Oversight** assumes no fiscal impact.

### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

### **DESCRIPTION**

The act modifies the circumstances wherein a territory located in a public water supply district can detach. A territory may detach if the district has not made service available, provided no loans greater than twenty-five thousand dollars are outstanding. Consent to detach is not needed if the district cannot provide water lines to the territory in question within three years after a request for service has been made.

The act requires any political subdivision, municipal corporation or private entity to first petition the court for the territory in question to be detached and before any infrastructure may be built.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
