FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri House of Representatives**, the **Missouri Senate**, the **Office of the Governor**, and the **Office of Administration**, **Office of the Commissioner**, and **Division of Budget and Planning** assume this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State** (SOS) stated that statewide newspaper publication of constitutional amendments would cost approximately \$1,752 per column inch per publication date based on an estimate provided by the Missouri Press Service. The SOS estimated this proposal would require 10 column inches including title header and certification paragraph, for three required publications. ((\$1,752 x 3=\$5,256) x 10=\$52,560).

Oversight assumes the proposal would be submitted to the voters in November 2006.
