No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION

This proposal prohibits the Department of Social Services--Children's Division from closing a child abuse or neglect investigation involving the death of a child until all criminal proceedings involving such death are finally adjudicated.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
