#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Revenue** assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

Officials from the **Office of the State Treasurer** state they do not approve disbursements, as stated in the proposal. The STO only ensures the disbursements are made from a lawful appropriation and do not exceed the amount of the appropriation. Without changing the wording of the bill, the STO assumes the need for one FTE Analyst I (at \$36,444 annually plus E&E) to monitor these disbursements.

**Oversight** assumes there will not be enough monies in the new fund to require an additional FTE within the Office of the State Treasurer. Oversight assumes collections of less than \$100,000 per year.

Officials from the Office of Administration, Budget and Planning (BAP) did not respond to our fiscal note request.

This legislation could increase Total State Revenues.
