#### ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Office of Administration, Office of State Courts Administrator,
Department of Economic Development, Department of Elementary and Secondary
Education, Department of Higher Education, Department of Mental Health, Department of
Natural Resources, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Department of Social
Services, Missouri Department of Transportation, Department of Public Safety, Office of
the Governor, Department of Insurance, Missouri Lottery, Missouri Department of
Conservation, Missouri Health Facilities Review Commission, Missouri House of
Representatives, Missouri Lieutenant Governor, Office of State Auditor, Missouri Senate,
Office of State Treasurer, Department of Revenue, Kansas City Election Board, and Platte
County Election Board assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **Office of Secretary of State (SOS)** state the fiscal impact for this proposal to the SOS for administrative rules is less than \$1,500. The SOS does not expect additional funding would be required to meet these costs. However, the SOS recognizes that many such bills may be passed by the General Assembly in a given year and that collectively the costs may be in excess of what the office can sustain with its core budget. Therefore, the SOS reserves the right to request funding for the cost of supporting administrative rules requirements should the need arise based on a review of the finally approved bills signed by the Governor.

## ASSUMPTION (continued)

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services (DOH)** state the proposal appeals laws relating to the Crippled Children's Service Fund (Section 33.575). Were this fund to be eliminated, additional general revenue would be needed to replace the lost revenue to maintain the current level of care for children with special health care needs. Eliminating this fund will result in a loss of \$6,100 in FY 07; \$7,320 for FY 08; and \$7,320 for FY 09.

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General** and **Department of Corrections** did not respond to our request for a statement of fiscal impact.
