### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

### DESCRIPTION

This proposal would modify provisions relating to the Missouri Women's Council, adding certain mandates:

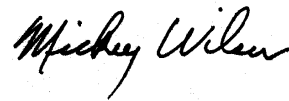
- Initiate programs to assist and support women when making the transition from work to home, operating a home-based business, and working part-time from home;
- Provide information for women to access traditional and nontraditional skilled trades through greater participation in apprenticeship programs and vocational and technical training;
- Promote workforce readiness skills for unemployed women especially in growth sectors;
- Conduct programs, studies, seminars, and conferences in cooperation with federal, state, local agencies, and private companies and organizations in the following areas:
  - (a) Occupational needs and opportunities;
  - (b) Balancing work and family;
  - (c) Financial planning;
  - (d) Procurement opportunities for women;
- Conduct an inventory of existing federal, state, community, and private programs and facilities relating to economic and employment needs of women and to make that available to the women of the state; and
- Determine which economic and employment problems exist in specific geographic areas of the state by developing a self-sufficiency standard.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
