FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Office of State Courts Administrator, the Office of Administration, Division of Accounting, and Division of Budget and Planning, the Department of Corrections, and the Department of Revenue assume this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Oversight notes that the proposal would authorize appropriations to the Missouri Arts Council for subsidies to public television stations. The subsidies would be limited to fifty cents for each resident of the state as determined by the most recent federal decennial census. According to the United States Census Bureau, the population of the state was 5,595,211 in 2000. Therefore, the maximum amount of appropriations would be \$2,797,606.

Oversight assumes it is the intent of this legislation to create a program to subsidize public television station operations in the state of Missouri, and has ranged the cost of the program from \$0 to \$2,797,606 to the General Revenue Fund.
