ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department** did not respond.

Officials of the **St. Louis City - Budget Division** assume this substitute would allow the St. Louis City Board of Police Commission members to determine police salaries. Officials assume any increase in salaries would be discretionary. Officials stated that any increase in salaries is indeterminable and is unknown. Officials assume fiscal impact would be \$0 if no salary increase were made to unknown if the Board in their discretion would approve increases.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

DESCRIPTION

This proposal modifies the law regarding St. Louis Police Officers.

As of August 28, 2006, the Board of Police Commissioners would have the authority to compute and establish the annual salary of each member of the St. Louis City police force without receiving prior authorization from the General Assembly.


This act contains an emergency clause and has an effective date of June 26, 2006.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
