ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Administrative Hearing Commission** assume the proposal will not significantly alter its caseload and assumes no fiscal impact from the proposal.

Officials from the **Office of Administration - Budget and Planning** assume no fiscal impact from the proposal.

Officials from the **Department of Economic Development (DED)** assume the bill should have no impact on their agency or the Missouri Development Finance Board (MDFB). DED states that however, it will have an administrative impact on the operations of the MDFB. The bill prohibits the MDFB from granting tax credits or loan guarantees to professional athletic teams or sports authorities.
