No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation modifies provisions relating to criminal background checks when there has been an emergency placement of a child in a private home. Under current law, the criminal background check must be made within fifteen business days and there is an exception for conducting background checks for family members who are within the second degree of consanguinity of the child. The proposal provides that the criminal background check be made within fifteen calendar days and removes the family member exception.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
