FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Mental Health (DMH)** state the proposal requires the DMH to develop a plan to address the needs of persons who are on a waiting list for services. The development of the plan would not create a fiscal impact on the DMH; the cost of developing the plan would be absorbed by existing staff. However, while there is no fiscal impact for development of the plan, it should be noted that implementation of the plan would result in a significant fiscal impact to the DMH.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services - Division of Medical Services (DMS)** state the proposed legislation requires the DMH to annually submit a copy of the plan, addressing the needs of people who are on a waitlist for services, to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president pro tem of the senate, and the governor. The report must be completed on or before November first each year, beginning November 1, 2007.

Since the responsibility to produce and submit the plan belongs to the DMH, there would be no fiscal impact to the DMS.
