## **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Transportation (MoDOT)** assume this proposal would eliminate MoDOT's requirements to print bid books and send addenda to contractors by certified mail, which would result in annual savings of \$18,000 and \$72,000 respectively.

#### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

Under this act, the Highways and Transportation Commission is authorized to receive bids and bid bonds for any contract for construction, maintenance, repair, or improvement of any bridge or highway on the state highway system electronically via the Internet. At its discretion, the commission may elect to receive both electronic and paper bids, or the commission may specify electronic bidding exclusively for any proposed contract. The act establishes minimum criteria for the electronic bidding program.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
