ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** and the **Department of Transportation** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Directors Office (DPS)** assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their agency. DPS stated the proposal is a language clean-up bill. DPS stated Section 388.610 in Senate Bill 1213 was passed in 2002 and gave the director of DPS the responsibility of appointing RR police officers but did not change the language in the adjoining paragraphs.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION
