ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** stated this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency or on local school districts.

A request for fiscal impact was sent to the Mexico, Sedalia, and Salisbury School Districts, as well as other school districts, who did not respond.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

DESCRIPTION

This proposed legislation requires the state board of education to annually establish a target school start date. Each local board of education shall vote annually to accept the target date or to adopt an alternative start date while asserting the reason for varying from the target date. However, such reason shall not include additional preparation time for any academic assessment.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
