DESCRIPTION

This proposal repeals the statute creating the Advisory Committee on Poison Control and repeals some of its duties. This proposal provides that rather than the advisory committee, the state health agency shall provide for the establishment of a Missouri Regional Poison Information Center and Network and shall work in conjunction with local health agencies and health care providers on the region to be served by the Missouri regional poison information center.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
