ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety (DPS) - Director's Office** and **Office of State Treasurer** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **DPS - Missouri Veterans' Commission (VET)** state the fiscal impact to the VET would depend on the program(s) implemented and the fund(s) impacted. Depending on the magnitude of the program, the VET could require additional funding and FTE. The VET is unable to determine the potential fiscal impact.

Officials from the **Office of Lieutenant Governor (MLG)** assume the proposal will only be administered if money is appropriated to the Veterans' Historical Education Trust Fund. Therefore, the MLG assumes the proposal will have no fiscal impact.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

DESCRIPTION

Current law states that the General Assembly shall encourage the development of any veterans' programs related to education about the historical significance of veteran service. This proposal provides that the Lieutenant Governor, rather than the Veterans' Commission, shall administer the provisions of the section.

The proposal also provides that the Lieutenant Governor, rather than the Veterans' Commission, shall administer the Veterans' Historical Education Fund.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
