FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

DESCRIPTION

Currently, a member of the Highway Patrol cannot accept other employment without the written permission of the Superintendent. This proposal would also allow members to take secondary employment under a general order issued by the Superintendent setting forth the circumstances under which such employment would be allowed.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
