FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **City of St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department - Budget Division** assumes this proposal could cost the St. Louis Police Department somewhere between \$800,000 and \$1,000,000 annually if its passage will cause the Department of Labor to force the department to pay overtime to police sergeants.

Oversight assumes this proposal as written gives the St. Louis Police Board authority, at their discretion, to pay overtime compensation to sergeants. **Oversight** assumes this proposal does not require the Police Board to authorize additional compensation for overtime, therefore, **Oversight** will show annual fiscal impact as \$0 or (\$800,000 to \$1,000,000).

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This act relates to St. Louis police officer compensation.

Currently, St. Louis police officers of the rank of sergeant or above cannot receive additional compensation or comp time for overtime, court time, or standby court time. This act prohibits such compensation for officers of the rank of lieutenant or above, but sergeants are allowed to receive additional compensation for overtime if the accumulated time is over 40 hours.

This act allows the St. Louis Board of Police Commissioners to pay additional compensation for all hours of service rendered by sergeants in excess of the established regular working hours.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
