**FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business**

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This act requires the Missouri Ethics Commission to post a listing organized by candidate, showing contributions made in support of and in opposition to each candidate, together with the date and amount of each contribution. The list shall be organized into two categories labeled "expenditures in support of the candidate" and "expenditures in opposition to the candidate".

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
