FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Higher Education** assume this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from **Missouri Western State University** stated this proposal would give them the authorization to lease campus-owned property not currently being used if a future economic/educational development would require it. University officials assume that any potential fiscal impact would be equal to the rent received.

Oversight assumes that this proposal would have a future positive fiscal impact to Missouri Western State University. Any fiscal impact would result from a potential future lease agreement, and the amount and fiscal years affected are unknown. Oversight has not included that potential revenue in this fiscal note.
