FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Higher Education** assume this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from **Missouri Western State University** stated that a previous version of this proposal would give them the authorization to lease campus-owned property not currently being used if a future economic/educational development would require it. University officials assume that any potential fiscal impact would be equal to the rent received.

Oversight assumes that this proposal would have a future positive fiscal impact to the universities. Any fiscal impact would result from a potential future lease agreement, and the amount and fiscal years affected are unknown. Oversight has not included that potential revenue in this fiscal note.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION

This proposal would authorize Missouri Western State University, Southeast Missouri State University, Central Missouri State University, Missouri State University, Missouri Southern State University, Northwest Missouri State University, and Harris-Stowe State University to convey or transfer, except in fee simple, the title or interest in real property.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
