Officials from the **Department of Higher Education** assumed a previous version of this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from **Missouri Western State University** stated that a previous version of this proposal would give them the authorization to lease campus-owned property not currently being used if a future economic/educational development would require it. University officials assume that any potential fiscal impact would be equal to the rent received.

Officials from Southeast Missouri State University, Missouri State University, Missouri Southern State University, Northwest Missouri State University, Lincoln University, and Harris-Stowe State University did not respond to our request for information.
