#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the Missouri House of Representatives, the Office of State Courts
Administrator, the Office of the Secretary of State, the Office of the State Auditor, the
Office of Administration, Administrative Hearing Commission and Division of Budget and
Planning, the Department of Agriculture, the Department of Elementary and Secondary
Education, the Department of Public Safety, Office of the Director, Capitol Police, State
Emergency Management Agency, Missouri Gaming Commission, and Missouri Highway
Patrol, the Department of Social Services, the Joint Committee on Public Employee
Retirement, and the Joint Committee on Legislative Research, assume this proposal would
have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety**, **Missouri Veterans Commission** (VETS) assume this proposal could result in additional costs to the General Revenue Fund and the Veterans Home Fund in cases where a case is filed in the courts and not resolved through an administrative appeal.

**Oversight** assumes this proposal would not have a significant fiscal impact on any state agency or fund.

### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

This proposal would modify the process for review of an administrative agency's decisions. In cases where the law provides for an independent review of an agency's decision by a board other than the Administrative Hearing Commission and further provides for a de novo review of the board's decision by the circuit court, an aggrieved party may, within thirty days after it receives notice of that decision, waive independent review by that board and file a petition in the circuit court for the de novo review of the agency's decision.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
