FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of Lieutenant Governor**, the **Missouri House of Representative**, and the **Missouri Senate** assume this proposal would not fiscally impact their agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services (DOH)** state the Missouri Senior Rx Plan is to sunset during FY 2006 and is replaced by the Missouri Rx Plan. DOH states all funds related to the Missouri Rx Plan and the Missouri Rx Plan Advisory Commission are being transferred from DOH to the Department of Social Services in the FY 2007 budget. DOH assumes this proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services - Division of Medical Services (DMS)** assume this proposal transfers the Missouri Rx Plan Advisory Commission from the Department of Health and Senior Services to the Department of Social Services. DMS assumes four FTE would be need to carry out the function of the Missouri Rx Plan advisory Commission and for support. The FTE would be a Medicaid Program Relations Representative, two Medicaid Specialist, and a Medicaid Clerk. In addition, DMS assumes \$233,954 would be needed to support the Commission and to assist in the establishment of a clearinghouse to educate Missourians on quality prescription drug programs and to assist Missouri residents in enrolling in or accessing prescription drug assistance programs.
