## FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Office of Lieutenant Governor**, the **Missouri House of Representative**, and the **Missouri Senate** assume this proposal would not fiscally impact their agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services (DOH)** state the Missouri Senior Rx Plan is to sunset during FY 2006 and is replaced by the Missouri Rx Plan. DOH states all funds related to the Missouri Rx Plan and the Missouri Rx Plan Advisory Commission are being transferred from DOH to the Department of Social Services in the FY 2007 budget. DOH assumes this proposal would not fiscally impact their agency.

Officials from the **Department of Social Services - Division of Medical Services (DMS)** state in August, 2005, an executive order transferred the Commission and its duties from the Department of Health and Senior Services to the Department of Social Services. This proposal codifies in statute the transfer that has already taken place by executive order.

#### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

This proposal modifies the provisions relating to the Missouri RX Plan Advisory Commission to reflect that the Missouri RX Plan is no longer housed in the Department of Health and Senior Services but in the Department of Social Services. This proposal removes the provision in the Missouri Rx statute denying eligibility to individuals enrolled in Medicare Advantage Plans.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
