FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This act designates the portion of Highway 21 from the intersection of Lindbergh Avenue to the intersection of Gravois Road in St. Louis County as the "Sergeant William McEntee Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs commemorating this portion of highway. Costs for such designation shall be paid for by the Kirkwood Police officers.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
