No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


### DESCRIPTION

This proposal modifies the provisions relating to persons donating blood. This act provides that persons sixteen years of age may donate blood if that person obtains written permission or authorization from his or her parent or guardian.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
