FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE)** state this proposed legislation will have no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the **Missouri Senate** state this proposal will either have no fiscal impact as it relates to their agency or minimal costs which can be absorbed by present appropriations.

Officials from the **University of Missouri** state the University would incur no additional costs as a result of the passage of this proposal.

Officials from the **Office of the Governor** stated the proposed legislation should not result in additional costs or savings to the Governor's Office.

Oversight assumes the operation of the commission, including the hiring of an executive direction, would be subject to appropriations and/or private donations. Implementation of programs would not occur unless sufficient funding is generated.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION

This proposed legislation creates the Holocaust Education and Awareness Commission. The commission shall be housed in the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education and shall promote implementation of holocaust education and awareness programs. The commission shall be composed of twelve members to be appointed by the governor with advice and consent of the senate. The makeup of the commission, including the president of the University of Missouri system, is delineated in the act. The term "holocaust" is defined in the act.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
