ASSUMPTION

DESCRIPTION

This proposed legislation creates the Holocaust Education and Awareness Commission. The commission shall be housed in the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education and shall promote implementation of holocaust education and awareness programs. The commission shall be composed of twelve members to be appointed by the governor with advice and consent of the senate. The makeup of the commission, including the president of the University of Missouri system, is delineated in the act. The term "holocaust" is defined in the act.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
