FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Transportation** and **Department of Revenue** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Oversight notes that this proposal is federally mandated under the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) enacted August 10, 2005, as public law 109-59. Section 4141 of SAFETEA-LU amended 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 31111(b)(1) by adding paragraph (D) which prohibits states from prescribing or enforcing a regulation that imposes a vehicle length limitation of not less than or more than 97 feet on a driveway saddlemount with fullmount vehicle transporter combinations.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact.
