ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Department of Revenue - Office of Administrative Information

Technology (ITSD DOR) estimate that this proposed legislation could be implemented utilizing existing resources of 1 FTE at a CIT III for 1 month at a rate of \$4,186. However, if priorities shift and additional FTE/overtime would be needed to implement, the cost will be approximately \$4,186. Officials from DOR state that funding, if costs were to be incurred, would be requested through appropriations by Office of Administration - Information Technology.
