ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General, Office of Administration (COA) - Administrative Hearing Commission, COA - Division of Budget and Planning, COA - Children's Trust Fund, Office of State Courts Administrator, Department of Health and Senior Services, Department of Social Services, Department of Public Safety (DPS) - Director's Office, DPS - Missouri State Highway Patrol, Office of Lieutenant Governor, Missouri Senate, and Office of State Public Defender** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Corrections, Office of the Governor, Missouri House of Representatives, and Office of Prosecution Services** did not respond to our request for a statement of fiscal impact. However, based on responses from an earlier version of this proposal and other similar legislation (HB 954 and HB 935), **Oversight** assumes the proposal would have no fiscal impact on these agencies.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact.
