FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

Yes. All electrical corporations would be required to make a good faith effort to generate renewable energy technologies. The objective of the legislation is to ensure that by 2012, 3% of electrical energy is generated by renewable energy technologies, increasing to 7% by 2015, and 10% generated by eligible renewable technologies by 2020.

Electrical suppliers would be required to provide documentation to the Department and the Public Service Commission demonstrating good faith efforts to reach the goal of renewable energy use.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
