FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their agency or on local school districts.

Oversight assumes, based on §160.900 through §160.930 (Enacted 2005 - SB 500) and §162.700, (As amended with SB 834 in 2006), that the First Steps Program will sunset on August 28, 2007, unless reauthorized by the General Assembly. The General Revenue appropriation has been as follows:

Other funding sources for the First Steps Program will not be impacted, so long as the program is reauthorized. **Oversight** will assume level funding for the next three years. (§160.930)
