ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Office of Administration (COA) - Administrative Hearing Commission, COA - Division of Budget and Planning, COA - Division of Information Technology Services, Office of State Courts Administrator, Department of Economic Development -Public Service Commission, Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, Department of Higher Education, Missouri Department of Transportation, Department of Insurance, Financial and Professional Regulation, Department of Mental Health, Department of Natural Resources, Department of Corrections, Department of Health and Senior Services (DOH), DOH - Certificate of Need Program, Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Department of Revenue, Department of Social Services, Department of Public Safety (DPS) - Director's Office, DPS - Division of Fire Safety, DPS - Missouri Gaming Commission, DPS - Missouri State Highway Patrol, DPS - Missouri Veterans' Commission, DPS - Missouri State Water Patrol, Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, Joint Committee on Public Employee Retirement, Department of Agriculture, Missouri Department of Conservation, Missouri Ethics Commission, Missouri House of Representatives, Office of Lieutenant Governor, Office of State Auditor, Missouri Senate, Office of State Public Defender, Office of State Treasurer, State Tax Commission, University of Central Missouri, Harris-Stowe State College, Lincoln University, Linn State Technical College, Kansas City Metropolitan Community College, Missouri State University, Parkway School District, Truman State University, University of Missouri, City of Centralia, City of Kansas City, City of Kirksville, City of West Plains, Randolph County **Health Department,** and **St. Louis County** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General (AGO)** assume this legislation may require that it consult with state agencies, boards or commissions regarding any rules that such agencies may promulgate in reference to professional counselors or referrals to professional counselors. The AGO assumes that it would represent any state agency, board or commission that is sued for alleged discrimination against professional counselors.

The AGO assumes that any costs associated with these new responsibilities could be absorbed with existing resources. However, if this legislation generated litigation against multiple state agencies, boards or commissions, the AGO would seek necessary additional appropriations to handle those multiple cases.

Officials from the **Office of Secretary of State (SOS)** state the fiscal impact for this proposal is less than \$2,500. The SOS does not expect that additional funding would be required to meet these costs. However, the SOS also recognizes that many such bills may be passed by the

General Assembly in a given year and that collectively the costs may be in excess of what the SOS can sustain within its core budget. Therefore, the SOS reserves the right to request funding for the costs of supporting administrative rules requirements should the need arise based on a review of the finally approved bills signed by the Governor.

Officials from the **Office of Prosecution Services** did not respond to our request for a statement of fiscal impact.
