FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Revenue, Department of Transportation, Department of Insurance, Finance, and Professional Regulation, Department of Public Safety - Missouri State Highway Patrol, and Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** stated there would be no fiscal impact as a result of this proposed legislation on their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** responded, but were unable to provide an estimate of fiscal impact.

Officials from the **St Joseph Police Department** state that if this proposal is enacted, revenues to their city are likely to be at least five figures.

Officials from the **Boone County Sheriff's Department** and the **Springfield Police Department** stated there would be no fiscal impact to their respective agencies.

Requests for responses were sent to: **Columbia Police Department, Independence Police Department, St Charles Police Department, St Louis County Department of Police, and St Louis Metro Police Department**, none of which responded.

Oversight assumes that a significant amount of revenues could be collected for the red light infraction, based on information from other states.

Any person who commits a steady red light violation that is detected and enforced through an automated photo red light enforcement system is guilty of an infraction.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.


