FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services** and **Public Service Commission** assume no fiscal impact to their agency.

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources** assume this proposal would establish a new state-funded grant program for construction and demolition waste reduction. The Department of Natural Resources would be tasked with administering the new grant program. Section 260.225.1(9) of this proposal states that the new program would be subject to appropriation. The proposed legislation does not establish a new source of revenue.
