FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume no fiscal impact on the Courts.

Officials of the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume the municipal court structure may reduce the amount of fine revenue to Kansas City school districts. Officials did not estimate fiscal impact.

Officials of the **City of Kansas City - Office of City Attorney** assume this proposal would enable the City to establish an administrative tribunal system. Office assume if the city elected not to establish a system the fiscal impact would be zero.

Officials stated the savings would result from inspectors spending less time in court when defendants don't show up, which causes costs associated with serving bench warrants and attending rescheduled court hearings. If it works as anticipated, code enforcement cases will be resolved faster, thereby increasing efficiency and generating additional savings.

Oversight assumes this proposal as written is enabling legislation and does not require the City of Kansas City to establish an administrative system to deal with municipal code violations. **Oversight** assume no state or local fiscal impact.
