FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator, Department of Public Safety (DPS) - Director's Office, DPS - Missouri State Highway Patrol, Office of State Treasurer, Department of Economic Development (DED) - Office of Public Council, and DED - Public Service Commission** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **Office of Prosecution Services (OPS)** assume the proposal would not have a significant direct fiscal impact on county prosecutors or the OPS.

Officials from the **Office of Secretary of State (SOS)** state the fiscal impact for this proposal is less than \$2,500. The SOS does not expect that additional funding would be required to meet these costs. However, the SOS also recognizes that many such bills may be passed by the General Assembly in a given year and that collectively the costs may be in excess of what the SOS can sustain within its core budget. Therefore, the SOS reserves the right to request funding for the costs of supporting administrative rules requirements should the need arise based on a review of the finally approved bills signed by the Governor.

Officials from the **Department of Insurance, Financial and Professional Regulation** state having reviewed the proposed legislation and having sought the conclusion of the appropriate board (s), they are of the opinion the proposal, in its present form, has no impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General (AGO)** did not respond to our request for a statement of fiscal impact. However, in response to an earlier version of this proposal, the AGO assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

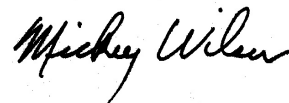
The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact.
