FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Office of Administration's General Services** assume that there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **Office of the State Treasurer** assume in FY 06 there was a biennial transfer of \$464,910.27 from the OA Revolving Trust Fund to General Revenue. With the proposed change in the language, this transfer would have been zero. There were no biennial transfers from the OA Revolving Trust Fund to General Revenue during FY 04 and FY 02. Due to the difficulty in projecting future fund balances and appropriations in future years, we estimate the fiscal impact of these changes from zero to unknown.

Oversight assumes there is no impact to state funds from this proposal.
