ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Revenue, Department of Public Safety - Missouri State Highway Patrol, and Department of Agriculture** state there will be no fiscal impact to their respective agencies as a result of this proposed legislation.

Officials from the **Department of Transportation** assumed there would be a fiscal impact to the Highway Fund as a result of this proposal. Officials from the Department of Revenue state that implements of husbandry are already included in the definition of "special mobile equipment" and are already exempt from titling and registration requirements per §301.133, RSMo.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact.
