#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Insurance**, **Financial Institutions**, and **Professional Registration**, the **City of Centralia**, and the **City of West Plains** assume this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the **Department of Revenue** (DOR) stated that the proposal would require an official statement that no taxes are due to be presented prior to the issuance of a city, county, or state license. No fiscal impact is anticipated for the Department of Revenue.

In order to facilitate this process, DOR is creating an internet based secure account access web page which would allow a business to obtain such a letter from their office or home computer. Information Technology (ITSD/DOR) estimates the IT portion of this request can be accomplished within existing resources, however; if priorities shift, additional FTE/overtime would be needed to implement this proposal. ITSD/DOR estimates that this legislation could be implemented utilizing 4 existing CIT III for 4 months and 1 CIT III to maintain the program, at a rate of \$66,976.

DOR officials stated that the proposal would be expected to have a positive fiscal impact for the state and for local governments but could not provide an estimate of additional taxes which would be collected.

**Oversight** will indicated a positive unknown fiscal impact for the General Revenue Fund, Various State Funds, and Local Governments.

### **FISCAL DESCRIPTION**

This proposal would require a business to obtain a statement from the Department of Revenue that no sales or withholding taxes were due prior to the issuance of any city or county occupation license, or any state license which is required for the sale of goods at retail.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
