FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Agriculture (AGR)** assume no fiscal impact to their agency.

Officials from the **Secretary of State's Office (SOS)** assume based on current content and distribution of the School Information Packet as published, the SOS would revise the materials of the packet to include the newly designated state symbol. The estimated cost to revise the packet for the approximately 100,000 packets distributed each fiscal year is \$500. At this point SOS will have to redesign the symbols page to accommodate the ever increasing number of state symbols they have.

Based on the current content and layout of the state symbols section of the Official Manual, the SOS would revise this section to include a photo of the symbol and may result in additional page(s) to the book. The estimated cost of revising this section of the Official Manual would be \$0.03 per book. Additionally, the office would incur the cost payment to an artist for a rendition of the new symbol based on historical costs, this is approximately \$100 per symbol. (\$500 FY08, \$515 FY09 & \$530 FY10 modification of school packet, \$1,200 FY08, \$1,236 FY 09 & \$1,273 FY10 addition of official game bird)

Oversight assumes the SOS could absorb the costs of printing and distributing packets and sections of the State Manual related to this proposal. If multiple bills pass which require the printing and distribution of packets at substantial costs, the SOS could request funding through the appropriation process.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

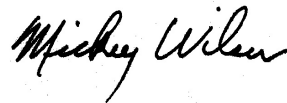
FISCAL DESCRIPTION
