FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT)** assume the language in this bill does not require installation of signing. If it is the intent to provide highway signing, the total cost of two signs, one for each direction will be \$2,200.00. This includes fabrication, installation and maintenance. In addition to these costs, MoDOT will have to maintain the signs for as long as they are up. The bill indicates the signs will be paid for by private donations. If no money is received then the department will not erect the signs.

Officials at the **Missouri Highway Patrol** assume that there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact.
