§163.031.2

This proposal grants hold harmless school districts, located entirely within St. Charles County, an additional payment equal to the decrease, if any, in the amount the district receives from fines in the current year from fines revenue the district received in fiscal year 2005.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
