FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Economic Development** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on the courts.

Officials from the **Office of the Attorney General (AGO)** assume the implementation of this proposal will create no fiscal impact for this office. However, because the AGO is responsible for defending such legislation in constitutionality claims, AGO assumes that the nature of these provisions could create a fiscal impact. As a result, AGO assumes costs are unknown, but under \$100,000.

Oversight assumes the AGO could absorb the cost of defending any constitutionality claims resulting from the proposed legislation within existing resources. If the AGO experiences increased costs that would require additional funding, the AGO could request the funding through the appropriation process.
