FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator, Department of Health & Senior Services** and **Department of Agriculture** assume no fiscal impact to their agency.

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources (DNR)** assumes this proposal would clarify DNR's legal authority to issue Class II concentrated animal feeding operations (CAFOs) permits for smaller operations who may need permits to satisfy lender requirements. Those facilities would still be eligible for state revolving funds.

Officials from the **Attorney General's Office** did not respond to our request for a fiscal impact from their agency.

The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
